5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 51.933, Education Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
8	(b-1) A rule adopted under Subsection (b) that requires a
9	hepatitis B vaccination for students must:
10	(1) only apply to a student enrolled in a course of
11	study that involves potential exposure to human or animal blood or
12	bodily fluids; and
13	(2) require the student to:
14	(A) receive the first shot of a series of
15	hepatitis B vaccine before the student begins the course of study;
16	and
17	(B) continue the series of hepatitis B vaccine
18	while training or working and complete the series according to
19	safety protocols adopted by the Centers for Disease Control and
20	Prevention of the United States Public Health Service.
21	SECTION 2. Not later than November 1, 2007, the executive
