| 3 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives |
| 4 | a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as |
| 5 | provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this |
| 6 | Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this |
| 7 | Act takes effect September 1, 2007. |
