- 8 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (h), the [The] operator
- 9 of a vehicle storage facility or governmental vehicle storage
- 10 facility may charge the owner of a vehicle stored or parked at the
- 11 facility:
- 12 (1) a notification fee set in a reasonable amount for
- 13 providing notice under this subchapter, including notice under
- 14 Section 2303.154(c);
- 15 (2) an impoundment fee of \$20 for any action that:
- 16 (A) is taken by or at the direction of the owner
- or operator of the facility; and
- 18 (B) is necessary to preserve, protect, or service
- 19 a vehicle stored or parked at the facility;
- 20 (3) a daily storage fee of:
- 21 (A) not less than \$5 and not more than \$20 for
- 22 each day or part of a day the vehicle is stored at the facility if
- 23 the vehicle is not longer than 25 feet; or
- 24 (B) \$35 for each day or part of a day the vehicle

- 1 is stored at the facility if the vehicle is longer than 25 feet; and
- 2 (4) any fee that is required to be submitted to a law
- 3 enforcement agency, the agency's authorized agent, or a
- 4 governmental entity.
- 5 (h) The operator of a vehicle storage facility or
- 6 governmental vehicle storage facility may not charge a fee under
- 7 Subsection (b) to the owner of a vehicle stored or parked at the
- 8 <u>facility as a result of recovery of the vehicle after being stolen.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
