Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended by adding Section 151.3211 to read as follows: 1-13 1-14 1-15 Sec. 151.3211. BOOKS PURCHASED BY UNIVERSITY AND COLLEGE STUDENTS FOR LIMITED PERIOD. (a) The sale of a book is exempted 1-16 from the taxes imposed by this chapter if: (1) the book is bought by a 1-17 full-time or part-time student enrolled at an institution of higher education as defined 1-18 1-19 1-20 by Section 61.003, Education Code, or a private or independent college or university that is located in this state and that is 1-21 accredited by a recognized accrediting agency under Section 61.003, 1-22 Education Code; and (2) 1-23 the sale takes place during a 10-day period: (A) beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the third Friday in August and ending at 12 midnight on the second Sunday following that date: or 1-24 1-25 that date; or 1-26 (B) beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the second Friday in January and ending at 12 midnight on the second Sunday following 1-27 1-28 that date. 1-29 1-30 A person may establish that the person is a full-time or (b) part-time student by presenting a valid student identification 1-31 1-32 1-33 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not affect taxes imposed before the effective date of this Act, and the 1-34 law in effect before the effective date of this Act is continued in 1-35 effect for purposes of the liability for and collection of those 1-36 1-37 taxes. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 2007, if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 1-38 1-39 1-40 1-41 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that 1-42 date, this Act takes effect October 1, 2007.

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
