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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to creation of an inflation adjustment to salaries for 3 classroom teachers and certain other professional staff employed by school districts. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsections (a), (c), and (d) and adding Subsections 7 (c-3), (c-4), (c-5), and (i) to read as follows: 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d) $\left[\frac{1}{r} + \frac{1}{r}\right]$ or (f), a 9 school district must pay each classroom teacher, full-time 10 librarian, full-time counselor certified under Subchapter B, or 11 12 full-time school nurse not less than the minimum monthly salary, based on the employee's level of experience in addition to other 13 14 factors, as determined by commissioner rule, prescribed by Subsection (c) and adjusted in accordance with Subsection (c-3) 15 [determined by the following formula: 16 17 $[MS - SF \times FS]$ 18 [where: ["MS" is the minimum monthly salary; 19 ["SF" is the applicable salary factor specified by Subsection 20 21 (c); and 22 ["FS" is the amount, as determined by the commissioner under Subsection (b), of state and local funds per weighted student, 23 including funds provided under Section 42.2516(b)(1)(B), but not 24

The commissioner shall determine the amount of the 8 adjustment for each school year based on the difference, if any, 9 between the Texas Consumer Price index most recently published by 10 the comptroller as of May 1 of the calendar year in which the school 11 12 year begins and the Texas Consumer Price index most recently published as of May 1, 2006. 13 (c-4) Notwithstanding Subsections (a) and (c-3), for the 14 15 2007-2008 school year, a classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time 16 17 school nurse is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal to the sum of: 18 (1) the monthly salary the employee would have 19 received for the 2007-2008 school year under the district's salary 20 21 schedule for the 2006-2007 school year, if that schedule had been in effect for the 2007-2008 school year, including any local 22 supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement 23 24 the employee would have received in the 2007-2008 school year; and (2) the amount necessary to reflect inflation, as 25 26 determined by the commissioner in the manner provided by Subsection 27 (c-3).

3	(d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time		
4	counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse		
5	employed by a school district in the <u>2007-2008</u> [2006-2007] school		
6	year is, as long as the employee is employed by the same district,		
7	entitled to a salary that is at least equal to <u>the greater of:</u>		
8	(1) the salary to which the employee is entitled under		
9	Subsection (c), as adjusted in accordance with Subsection (c-3); or		
10	(2) the salary that is equal to the sum of:		
11	(A) the salary the employee received for the		
12	preceding [2006-2007] school year; and		
13	(B) the amount necessary to reflect inflation, as		
14	determined by the commissioner in accordance with Subsection $(c-3)$.		
15	(i) The commissioner's determination under this section of		
16	an amount necessary to reflect inflation is final and may not be		
17	appealed.		
18	SECTION 2. Section 42.2512, Education Code, is amended by		
19	adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:		
20	(a-1) In addition to the amount specified by Subsection (a),		
21	a school district, including a school district that is otherwise		
22	ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled to state		
23	aid in an amount equal to the total amount of additional salary the		
24	district is required to pay under Section 21.402 solely to reflect		
25	inflation. If necessary to provide sufficient funds for purposes		
26	of this subsection, the Legislative Budget Board shall propose that		
27	the appropriate amount of money be transferred to the agency in		

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accordance with procedures specified by Chapter 317, Government 1 2 Code. SECTION 3. Sections 21.402(b) and (e), Education Code, are 3 4 repealed. 5 SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008 6 school year. SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10

11 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
