- 8 PURCHASING OR ATTEMPTING TO PURCHASE TOBACCO PRODUCTS BY A
- 9 MINOR UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE IS PROHIBITED BY LAW. SALE OR PROVISION
- 10 OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS TO A MINOR UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE IS PROHIBITED
- 11 BY LAW. UPON CONVICTION, A CLASS C MISDEMEANOR, INCLUDING A FINE OF
- 12 UP TO \$500, MAY BE IMPOSED. VIOLATIONS MAY BE REPORTED TO THE TEXAS
- 13 COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE BY CALLING (insert toll-free telephone
- 14 number). PREGNANT WOMEN SHOULD NOT SMOKE. SMOKERS ARE MORE LIKELY
- 15 TO HAVE BABIES WHO ARE BORN PREMATURE OR WITH LOW BIRTH WEIGHT.
- 16 (f) The comptroller may accept gifts or grants from any
- 17 public or private source to perform the comptroller's duties under
- 18 this section.
- 19 SECTION 2. The comptroller of public accounts shall adopt
- 20 rules as necessary to implement Section 161.084, Health and Safety
- 21 Code, as amended by this Act, not later than the 90th day after the
- 22 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
