## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to exemptions from the sales tax for certain school
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 151.327 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 151.327. SCHOOL BACKPACKS BEFORE START OF SCHOOL.
- 8 (a) The sale or storage, use, or other consumption of a school
- 9 backpack is exempted from the taxes imposed by this chapter if the
- 10 backpack is purchased:

backpacks.

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- (1) for use by a student in a public or private
- 12 elementary or secondary school;
- 13 (2) during the period described by Section
- 14 <u>151.326(a)(2); and</u>
- 15 (3) for a sales price of less than \$100.
- 16 (b) A retailer is not required to obtain an exemption
- 17 certificate stating that school backpacks are purchased for use by
- 18 students in a public or private elementary or secondary school
- 19 unless the backpacks are purchased in a quantity that indicates
- 20 that the backpacks are not purchased for use by students in a public
- 21 or private elementary or secondary school.
- 22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 23 affect taxes imposed before the effective date of this Act, and the
- law in effect before the effective date of this Act is continued in

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- 1 effect for purposes of the liability for and collection of those
- 2 taxes.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 2007, if it
- 4 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 5 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 6 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that
- 7 date, this Act takes effect October 1, 2007.
