1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to excepting from required disclosure under the public
1-11 information law certain personal information maintained by a
1-12 municipality that pertains to a minor.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
1-15 amended by adding Section 552.148 to read as follows:

1-16 Sec. 552.148. EXCEPTION: CERTAIN PERSONAL INFORMATION
1-17 MAINTAINED BY MUNICIPALITY PERTAINING TO A MINOR. (a) In this
1-18 section, "minor" means a person younger than 18 years of age.

1-19 (b) The following information maintained by a municipality
1-20 for purposes related to the participation by a minor in a
1-21 recreational program or activity is excepted from the requirements
1-22 of Section 552.021:

1-23 (1) the name, age, home address, home telephone
1-24 number, or social security number of the minor;

1-25 (2) a photograph of the minor; and

1-26 (3) the name of the minor's parent or legal guardian.

1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-28 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-29 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-30 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
