S.B. No. 132

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the establishment and operation of a motor bus-only 3 lane program. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 455, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 455.006 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 455.006. MOTOR BUS-ONLY LANE PROGRAM. (a) The 7 department, in consultation with the Department of Public Safety 8 9 and in conjunction with the metropolitan rapid transit authorities, regional transportation authorities, municipal transit 10 authorities, county mass transit authorities, and municipal mass 11 12 transportation departments in this state and the appropriate counties and municipalities, shall establish and operate a motor 13 14 bus-only lane program for highways that are part of the state highway system and have shoulders of sufficient width. 15 (b) The program shall: 16 (1) provide for the use by motor buses of highway 17 18 shoulders as a low-speed bypass of congested highway lanes; (2) gain local operational experience with the 19 conversion of existing highway shoulders to motor bus-only lanes 20 21 during peak traffic periods; and 22 (3) take into consideration the following: 23 (A) safety; 24 (B) travel time and reliability;

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1	(C) driver and passenger perceptions;
2	(D) level of service and maintenance; and
3	(E) capital improvements.
4	(c) The department shall initiate the motor bus-only lane
5	program as soon as practicable and not later than December 31, 2007,
6	submit a report to the legislature regarding the department's
7	progress in establishing and operating the program.
8	(d) Not later than December 31, 2008, and as part of the
9	review of the department in 2009 by the Sunset Advisory Commission
10	under Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act), the
11	department shall submit a final report to the legislature relating
12	to the motor bus-only lane program.
13	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
14	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
15	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
16	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

17 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
