4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 37.217 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 37.217. COMMUNITY EDUCATION RELATING TO INTERNET
8	SAFETY. (a) The center, in cooperation with the attorney general,
9	shall develop a program that provides instruction concerning
10	Internet safety, including instruction relating to:
11	(1) the potential dangers of allowing personal
12	information to appear on an Internet website;
13	(2) the manner in which to report an inappropriate
14	online solicitation; and
15	(3) the prevention, detection, and reporting of
16	bullying or threats occurring over the Internet.
17	(b) In developing the program, the center shall:
18	(1) solicit input from interested stakeholders; and
19	(2) to the extent practicable, draw from existing
20	resources and programs.
21	(c) The center shall make the program available to public
22	schools.
23	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
24	of this Act, the Texas School Safety Center shall develop a program

that provides instruction concerning Internet safety as required by
Section 37.217, Education Code, as added by this Act.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
