- 7 Sec. 61.0901. INCENTIVES TO PROMOTE RETENTION AND
- 8 GRADUATION OF NURSING STUDENTS. (a) In this section,
- 9 "professional nursing program" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 10 61.9621.
- 11 (b) The board shall consider and develop methods to promote
- 12 the retention and graduation of students enrolled in a professional
- 13 nursing program and shall adopt rules to implement those methods
- 14 the board considers feasible, including recommendations on
- 15 financial aid.
- 16 (c) The board by rule shall establish a program to recognize
- 17 a professional nursing program that achieves a graduation rate of
- 18 85 percent or more.
- 19 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2007, the Texas Higher
- 20 Education Coordinating Board shall adopt the rules required by
- 21 Subsection (c), Section 61.0901, Education Code, as added by this
- 22 Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
