- 9 SECTION 2. Section 311.022, Health and Safety Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
- 11 (c-1) An officer, employee, or medical staff member of a
- 12 general hospital may not inquire as to the immigration status or
- 13 nationality of a person who needs or receives emergency services,
- 14 unless the information is necessary to provide those services to
- 15 <u>the person.</u>
- SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 773, Health and Safety
- 17 Code, is amended by adding Section 773.016 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 773.016. REQUEST FOR CERTAIN INFORMATION PROHIBITED.
- 19 (a) Emergency medical services personnel, physicians, or emergency
- 20 room admissions personnel may not inquire as to the immigration
- 21 status or nationality of a patient who needs or receives emergency
- 22 medical services unless the information is necessary to provide
- 23 those services to the patient.
- 24 (b) The privilege of confidentiality under Section 773.091

- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
