A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the certification of educational diagnosticians. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 21.003(a), Education Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: (a) A person may not be employed as a teacher, teacher 6 7 intern or teacher trainee, librarian, educational aide, administrator, educational diagnostician, or counselor by a school 8 district unless the person holds an appropriate certificate or 9 permit issued as provided by Subchapter B. 10 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2008, the State Board 11 for Educator Certification shall propose rules governing the 12 certification of educational diagnosticians. 13 14 SECTION 3. Section 21.003(a), Education Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a person who begins employment with a 15 school district as an educational diagnostician on or after 16 September 1, 2008. A person employed by a school district as an 17 18 educational diagnostician before September 1, 2008, may continue employment with the school district without obtaining a certificate 19 or permit as an educational diagnostician as required by Section 20 21 21.003(a), Education Code, as amended by this Act, so long as the

22 person is employed by that district.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
