4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 54.5381 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 54.5381. INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS FEE: TEXAS STATE
8	UNIVERSITY SYSTEM. (a) The board of regents of the Texas State
9	University System may impose an intercollegiate athletics fee on
10	each student enrolled at a component institution of the Texas State
11	University System in an amount not to exceed:
12	(1) \$8.75 per semester credit hour for each regular
13	semester; and
14	(2) \$4.50 per semester credit hour for each summer
15	session.
16	(b) The fee may not be imposed unless approved by a majority
17	vote of the students of the applicable component institution who
18	participate in a general student election held for that purpose.
19	(c) A fee imposed under this section may be used to develop
20	and maintain an intercollegiate athletics program at the component
21	institution.
22	(d) Not more than once in an academic year, the board may
23	increase the amount of the fee authorized by this section. Any

increase of more than 10 percent must be approved by a majority vote

- of the students of the component institution who participate in a

- 3 (e) A fee imposed under this section is in addition to any
- 4 other fee authorized by law and may not be considered in determining
- 5 the maximum amount of student services fees that may be imposed
- 6 under Section 54.503.
- 7 <u>(f) If the imposition of a mandatory intercollegiate</u>
- 8 athletics fee as described by this section was approved by a
- 9 majority vote of the students of the component institution who
- 10 participated in a general student election held on or after January
- 11 1, 2005, the board may impose the fee as prescribed by the results
- 12 of the election without calling an additional election. This
- 13 subsection expires January 1, 2008.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2007 fall
- 15 semester.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
