- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 552.263(f), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (f) A requestor who fails to make a deposit or post a bond
- 8 required under Subsection (a) before the 10th business day after
- 9 the date the deposit or bond is required is considered to have
- 10 withdrawn the request for the copy of the public information that
- 11 precipitated the requirement of the deposit or bond.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 552.306(a), Government Code, is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 (a) Except as provided by Section 552.011, the attorney
- 15 general shall promptly render a decision requested under this
- 16 subchapter, consistent with the standards of due process,
- 17 determining whether the requested information is within one of the
- 18 exceptions of Subchapter C. The attorney general shall render the
- 19 decision not later than the 45th <u>business</u> [working] day after the
- 20 date the attorney general received the request for a decision. If
- 21 the attorney general is unable to issue the decision within the
- 22 45-day period, the attorney general may extend the period for
- issuing the decision by an additional 10 business [working] days by
- 24 informing the governmental body and the requestor, during the

- original 45-day period, of the reason for the delay.
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 552.307(b), Government Code, is amended
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 (b) If a decision is not requested under Subsection (a), the
- 5 governmental body shall release the information to the person with
- 6 a special right of access under Section 552.023 not later than the
- 7 10th <u>business</u> day after the date of receiving the request for
- 8 information.
- 9 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act to Sections
- 10 552.263, 552.306, and 552.307, Government Code, apply only in
- 11 relation to a request for public information that is made under
- 12 Chapter 552, Government Code, on or after the effective date of this
- 13 Act.
- 14 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
