9	SECTION 2. Section 2054.007, Insurance Code, as effective
10	April 1, 2007, is amended to read as follows:
11	Sec. 2054.007. [APPLICABILITY OF] OPEN MEETINGS LAW <u>AND</u>
12	OPEN RECORDS LAW NOT APPLICABLE. Notwithstanding any other state
13	law, Chapters [(a) Except as otherwise provided by Subsection (b),
14	Chapter] 551 and 552, Government Code, <u>do not apply</u> [applies] to the
15	company.
16	[(b) The board may hold closed meetings to consider:
17	[(1) information relating to claims, rates, or the

Section Code, as 2 effective April 1, 2007, is amended to read as follows: 3 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), a company 4 investigation file: 5 (1)is confidential [and not subject to required 6 disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code]; and 7 (2) may be disclosed only: 8 (A) in a criminal proceeding; 9 (B) in a hearing conducted by the commission; 10 (C) on a judicial determination of good cause; or (D) governmental 11 to а agency, political subdivision, or regulatory body if the disclosure is necessary or 12 proper for the enforcement of a law of this state, another state, or 13 14 the United States. 15 SECTION 5. Section 2054.256(b), Insurance Code, as effective April 1, 2007, is amended to read as follows: 16 The [Except as otherwise required or permitted by 17 (b) Chapter 552, Government Code, the] company may not provide to an 18 insurance agent information obtained from another insurance agent. 19 SECTION 6. Sections 2054.008(b) and (c), Insurance Code, as 20 effective April 1, 2007, are repealed. 21 SECTION 7. The change in law made by the amendment of 22 Section 2054.008, Insurance Code, by this Act applies 23 to 24 information maintained in investigation files of the Texas Mutual 25 Insurance Company without regard to the date the information is collected, compiled, or developed or otherwise becomes part of the 26 27 investigation file.

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1 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
