1-13 SECTION 1. Section 54.222, Education Code, is amended by 1-14 amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsection (b-1) to 1**-**15 1**-**16 read as follows:

governing board of an (b) The institution of higher education shall exempt from the payment of \$500 of the total amount of tuition a resident of this state enrolled as a student at the institution who:

is a registered nurse; and (1)

(2) <u>serves</u> [is serving] under a written preceptor agreement with an undergraduate professional nursing program as a clinical preceptor for students enrolled in the program.

A person is entitled to an exemption under Subsection (b-1) (b) for one semester or other academic term for each [the] semester or other academic term during [for] which the person serves as a clinical preceptor as described by Subsection (b). The person may claim the exemption in:

(1) the semester or other academic term in which the person serves as a clinical preceptor; or (2) a different semester or other academic term that

begins before the first anniversary of the last day of a semester or other academic term described by Subdivision (1), if the person does not claim the exemption in the semester or other term during which the person serves as a clinical preceptor [exemption sought].

The change in law made beginning with tuition charged for the law made by this Act applies for the 2007 fall semester. 1-50 1-51 Beginning with that semester, the governing board of a public institution of higher education shall grant a tuition exemption in 1-52 1-53 accordance with Section 54.222, Education Code, as amended by this Act, regardless of whether the qualifying service as a clinical 1-54 1-55 preceptor occurred before the effective date of this Act. Tuition 1-56 1-57 charged for a semester or term before the 2007 fall semester is 1-58 covered by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that 1-59 1-60 purpose.
