- Sec. 103.0015. NATURE OF COMPENSATION. Compensation under
- 8 <u>this chapter:</u>
- 9 <u>(1) represents damages for the physical injury of</u> 10 wrongful incarceration; and
- wrongrar incareeracion, and
- 11 (2) is not subject to federal income tax.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies to compensation awarded under Chapter 103, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, without regard to

whether the compensation was awarded before, on, or after the

- 15 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
