S.B. No. 213

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of certain counties to impose a county 3 hotel occupancy tax and to the rate of the tax.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 352.002, Tax Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (f) to read as 7 follows:

8 (a) The commissioners courts of the following counties by 9 the adoption of an order or resolution may impose a tax on a person 10 who, under a lease, concession, permit, right of access, license, 11 contract, or agreement, pays for the use or possession or for the 12 right to the use or possession of a room that is in a hotel, costs \$2 13 or more each day, and is ordinarily used for sleeping:

14 (1) a county that has a population of more than 3.3 15 million;

16 (2) a county that has a population of 90,000 or more,
17 borders the United Mexican States, and does not have three or more
18 cities that each have a population of more than 17,500;

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(3) a county in which there is no municipality;

20 (4) a county in which there is located an Indian
21 reservation under the jurisdiction of the United States government;

(5) a county that has a population of 30,000 or less,
that has no more than one municipality with a population of less
than 2,500, and that borders two counties located wholly in the

No. 213 Edwards Aquifer Authority established by Chapter 626, Acts of the 1 2 73rd Legislature, Regular Session, 1993; 3 a county that borders the Gulf of Mexico; (6) 4 (7) a county that has a population of less than 5,000, that borders the United Mexican States, and in which there is 5 located a major observatory; 6 7 (8) a county that has a population of 12,000 or less and borders the Toledo Bend Reservoir; 8 9 (9) a county that has a population of less than 12,000 and an area of less than 275 square miles; 10 11 (10)a county that has a population of 30,000 or less and borders Possum Kingdom Lake; 12 a county that borders the United Mexican States 13 (11)and has a population of more than 300,000 and less than 600,000; 14 15 (12)a county that has a population of 35,000 or more 16 and borders or contains a portion of Lake Fork Reservoir; (13) a county that borders the United Mexican States 17 18 and in which there is located a national recreation area; a county that borders the United Mexican States 19 (14)and in which there is located a national park of more than 400,000 20 21 acres; 22 a county that has a population of 28,000 or less, (15) that has no more than four municipalities, and that is located 23 wholly in the Edwards Aquifer Authority established by Chapter 626, 24 25 Acts of the 73rd Legislature, Regular Session, 1993; (16) a county that has a population of 25,000 or less, 26 27 whose territory is less than 750 square miles, and that has two

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incorporated municipalities, each with a population of 800 or less,
 located on the Frio River;

3 (17) a county that has a population of 34,000 or more4 and borders Lake Buchanan;

5 (18) a county that has a population of more than 45,000 6 and less than 75,000, that borders the United Mexican States, and 7 that borders or contains a portion of Falcon Lake;

8 (19) a county with a population of 21,000 or less that 9 borders the Neches River and in which there is located a national 10 preserve;

(20) a county that has a population of 22,500 or less
 and that borders or contains a portion of Lake Livingston; [and]

13 (21) a county that has a population of less than 22,000 14 and in which the birthplace of a president of the United States is 15 located; and

16 (22) a county that has a population of more than 15,000
17 but less than 20,000 and borders Lake Buchanan.

18 (f) The tax imposed by a county authorized by Subsection 19 (a)(22) to impose the tax does not apply to a hotel located in a 20 municipality.

21 SECTION 2. Subsection (g), Section 352.003, Tax Code, is 22 amended to read as follows:

(g) The tax rate in a county authorized to impose the tax under Section <u>352.002(a)(18)</u> [352.002(a)(17)] may not exceed two percent of the price paid for a room in a hotel.

26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
