## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the seal of a district court used on process issued by
- 3 the court.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 51.301(d), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (d) Each district clerk shall be provided with a seal for
- 8 the district court. The seal must have a five-pointed star and must
- 9 be engraved with the words "District Court of \_\_\_\_\_ County,
- 10 Texas." The seal shall be impressed on all process issued by the
- 11 court except subpoenas and shall be kept and used by the clerk to
- 12 authenticate official acts. The seal may be created using an
- 13 electronic means, including by using an optical disk or another
- 14 electronic reproduction technique, if the means by which the seal
- is impressed on an original document created using the same type of
- 16 electronic means does not allow for changes, additions, or
- deletions to be made to the document.
- SECTION 2. Section 51.301(d), Government Code, as amended
- 19 by this Act, applies to a process, other than a subpoena, issued by
- 20 a court on or after the effective date of this Act. A process issued
- 21 by a court before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- law in effect on the date the process was issued, and the former law
- 23 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
