SECTION 2. A school district's first report of income-producing contracts under Section 44.012, Education Code, as added by this Act, must be published or must be posted on the district's Internet website not later than October 15, 2007, or February 15, 2008, depending on the date the district's fiscal year begins.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
