## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the composition of a county bail bond board.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1704.053, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 1704.053. BOARD COMPOSITION. A board consists of:
- 7 (1) the sheriff or a designee from the sheriff's office
- 8 who must be the sheriff's administrator or a deputy sheriff of the
- 9 rank of at least sergeant;
- 10 (2) a district judge of the county having jurisdiction
- 11 over criminal matters and designated by the presiding judge of the
- 12 administrative judicial district or a designee of the district
- judge who is approved by the presiding judge;
- 14 (3) the county judge, a member of the commissioners
- 15 court designated by the county judge, or a designee approved by the
- 16 commissioners court;
- 17 (4) a judge of a county court or county court at law in
- 18 the county having jurisdiction over criminal matters and designated
- 19 by the commissioners court or a designee of the judge who is
- 20 approved by the commissioners court;
- 21 (5) the district attorney or an assistant district
- 22 attorney designated by the district attorney;
- 23 (6) a licensed bail bond surety or agent for a
- corporate surety in the county elected under Section 1704.0535, or

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- 1 a bail bond surety or agent for a corporate surety licensed in the
- 2 county who is designated by the elected surety or agent;
- 3 (7) a justice of the peace;
- 4 (8) the district clerk or the clerk's designee;
- 5 (9) the county clerk or the clerk's designee, if the
- 6 county clerk has responsibility over criminal matters;
- 7 (10) if appointed by the board, a presiding judge of a
- 8 municipal court in the county;
- 9 (11) if the county's principal municipality designates
- 10 a presiding judge in the municipal court system, the presiding
- 11 judge or a municipal judge from the system designated by the
- 12 presiding judge;
- 13 (12) the county treasurer or the treasurer's designee
- or, if appointed by the commissioners court in a county that does
- 15 not have a county treasurer, the person designated by the county
- 16 commissioners court to perform the duties of the county treasurer;
- 17 and
- 18 (13) a criminal defense attorney practicing in the
- 19 county and elected by other attorneys whose principal places of
- 20 business are located in the county and who are not legally
- 21 prohibited from representing criminal defendants or the designee of
- 22 the criminal defense attorney.
- 23 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act regarding the
- 24 composition of a county bail bond board do not affect the
- 25 entitlement of a member serving on a board immediately before the
- 26 effective date of this Act to continue to serve and function as a
- 27 member of the board for the remainder of the member's term. Those

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- 1 changes in law apply only to a member appointed on or after the
- 2 effective date of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
