9	To promote the public safety, the commissioners court of a county
10	with a population of more than 1.3 [2.2] million by order may
11	regulate the following <u>in the unincorporated area of the county</u> if
12	they occur on a public highway or road <u>,</u> [in the unincorporated area
13	of the county or] in the right-of-way of <u>a public</u> [the] highway or
14	road, or in a parking lot:
15	(1) the sale of items by a vendor of food or
16	<pre>merchandise, including live animals;</pre>
17	(2) the erection, maintenance, or placement of a
18	structure by a vendor of food or merchandise, including live
19	animals; and
20	(3) the solicitation of money.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
