5	SECTION 1. Subchapter J, Chapter 201, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 201.805 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 201.805. REPORTS AND INFORMATION. (a) The department
8	shall annually publish in appropriate media and on the department's
9	Internet website in a format that allows the information to be read
10	into a commercially available electronic database a statistical
11	comparison of department districts and the following information,
12	calculated on a per capita basis considering the most recent census
13	data and listed for each county and for the state for each fiscal
14	<pre>year:</pre>
15	(1) the number of square miles;
16	(2) the number of vehicles registered;
17	(3) the population;
18	(4) daily vehicle miles;
19	(5) the number of centerline miles and lane miles;
20	(6) construction, maintenance, and contracted routine
21	and preventive maintenance expenditures;
22	(7) combined construction, maintenance, and
23	contracted routine and preventive maintenance expenditures;
24	(8) the number of district and division office

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1	construction and maintenance employees;
2	(9) information regarding grant programs, including:
3	(A) Automobile Theft Prevention Authority
4	grants;
5	(B) Routine Airport Maintenance Program grants;
6	(C) Public Transportation Grant Program grants;
7	(D) Medical Transportation Program grants; and
8	(E) aviation grants or aviation capital
9	<pre>improvement grants;</pre>
10	(10) approved State Infrastructure Bank loans;
11	(11) Texas Traffic Safety Program grants and
12	expenditures;
13	(12) the dollar amount of any pass-through toll
14	agreements;
15	(13) the percentage of highway construction projects
16	<pre>completed on time;</pre>
17	(14) the percentage of highway construction projects
18	that cost:
19	(A) more than the contract amount; and
20	(B) less than the contract amount; and
21	(15) a description of real property acquired by the
22	department through the exercise of eminent domain, including the
23	acreage of the property and the location of the property.
24	(b) The department shall include information from all
25	department contracts in the statistical comparison and information
26	reports required under Subsection (a).
27	(c) The department shall annually publish in appropriate

1	media and on the department's Internet website in a format that
2	allows the information to be read into a commercially available
3	electronic database the following information for each fiscal year:
4	(1) the amount of money in the Texas Mobility Fund
5	itemized by the source of the money; and
6	(2) the amount of money received by the department:
7	(A) itemized by the source of the money; and
8	(B) compared to the amount of money appropriated
9	by the legislature to the department in the General Appropriations
10	Act.
11	(d) The department shall annually publish in appropriate
12	media and on the department's Internet website in a format that
13	allows the information to be read into a commercially available
14	electronic database a list of each contract the department has
15	with:
16	(1) a person required to register as a lobbyist under
17	Chapter 305, Government Code;
18	(2) a public relations firm; or
19	(3) a government consultant.
