5	SECTION 1. Section 223.014(a), Transportation Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) Subject to Section 371.051, the $[The]$ commission by rule
8	shall provide a method by which a bidder may submit a bid guaranty.
9	A rule may authorize the use of an electronic funds transfer, a
10	check, including an electronic check, a money order, an escrow
11	account, a trust account, a credit card issued by a financial
12	institution chartered by a state or the United States or by a
13	nationally recognized credit organization approved by the
14	department, or another method the commission determines to be
15	suitable. The department may require the payment of a discount or
16	service charge for the use of a credit card.
17	SECTION 2. Subtitle G, Title 6, Transportation Code, is
18	amended by adding Chapter 371 to read as follows:
19	CHAPTER 371. PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO MORE THAN
20	ONE TYPE OF TOLL PROJECT
21	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
22	Sec. 371.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
23	(1) "Toll project" means a toll project described by
24	Section 201.001(b), regardless of whether the toll project is:

1	(A) a part of the state highway system; or
2	(B) subject to the jurisdiction of the
3	department.
4	(2) "Toll project entity" means an entity authorized
5	by law to acquire, design, construct, operate, and maintain a toll
6	<pre>project, including:</pre>
7	(A) the department;
8	(B) a regional tollway authority under Chapter
9	<u>366;</u>
10	(C) a regional mobility authority under Chapter
11	370; and
12	(D) a county under Chapter 284.

14	SUBCHAPTER B. CONTRACT PROVISIONS
15	Sec. 371.051. PAYMENT TO TOLL PROJECT ENTITY BY CONTRACT
16	BIDDERS. A toll project entity may not require or accept any form
17	of payment from a bidder for a contract associated with a toll
18	project other than fees imposed to recover the toll project
19	entity's costs of reviewing the bid. This section does not prevent a
20	toll project entity from requiring a bidder to provide a form of
21	security, including a bid guaranty, necessary to reimburse the toll
22	project entity for a loss incurred as a result of a default by the
23	<u>bidder.</u>
24	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
