16	advertisement for a commercial purpose, the name of an individual
17	who is an active duty or former member of the United States armed
18	forces, who is a member or former member of a reserve component of
19	the United States armed forces, or who is a member or former member
20	of the state military forces, as defined by Section 431.001,
21	Government Code, or a picture of the individual in uniform in which
