10	(1) "Heir" means a surviving grandparent, parent,
11	sibling, child, or grandchild of a deceased individual.
12	(2) "Personal representative" means an executor,
13	independent executor, administrator, independent administrator, or
14	temporary administrator, together with their successors.
15	(b) A person commits an offense if the person uses, in ar
16	advertisement for a commercial purpose, the name of an individual
17	who is an active duty or former member of the United States Armed
18	Forces or a picture of the individual in uniform, without obtaining
19	the consent of:

- 20 <u>(1) the individual, if the individual is living; or</u>
- 21 (2) the individual's surviving spouse or personal
- 22 representative or a majority of the individual's adult heirs, if
- 23 <u>the individual is deceased.</u>
- (c) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
