14	more municipalities, each of which has a population of 250,000 or
15	more; <u>or</u>
16	(B) \$1,000 for the issuance or renewal of a
17	license, if the ordinance is adopted by the commissioners court of a
18	county with a population of 3.3 million or more;
19	(3) condition the license on the operation of the
20	junkyard or automotive wrecking and salvage yard only at a location
21	approved by the commissioners court; or
22	(4) establish grounds for suspending or revoking a
23	license if the junkyard or automotive wrecking and salvage yard is
24	not screened.
