4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 434, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 434.017 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 434.017. PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE AWARD. (a) The
8	commission may make a performance incentive award to an individual
9	or an entity for providing services to veterans as authorized by
10	Section 3(a) of the federal Jobs for Veterans Act (38 U.S.C. Section
11	<u>4112).</u>
12	(b) The performance incentive award may be monetary or
13	nonmonetary.
14	(c) A performance incentive award made under this section to
15	a state employee is not a promotion or a merit salary increase under
16	Chapter 659.
17	SECTION 2. Section 659.264, Government Code, is repealed.
18	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
