1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the Texas Veterans Commission's authority to make
1-9 performance incentive awards for providing services to veterans.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 434, Government Code, is
1-12 amended by adding Section 434.017 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 434.017. PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE AWARD. (a) The
1-14 commission may make a performance incentive award to an individual
1-15 or an entity for providing services to veterans as authorized by
1-16 Section 3(a) of the federal Jobs for Veterans Act (38 U.S.C. Section
1-17 4112).

1-18 (b) The performance incentive award may be monetary or
1-19 nonmonetary.

1-20 (c) A performance incentive award made under this section to
1-21 a state employee is not a promotion or a merit salary increase under
1-22 Chapter 659.

1-23 SECTION 2. Section 659.264, Government Code, is repealed.

1-24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
