Subsection (a), Section 547.004, Transportation 1-13 Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-14 (a) A person commits an offense that is a misdemeanor if the 1**-**15 1**-**16 person operates or moves or, as an owner, knowingly permits another to operate or move, a vehicle that: 1-17 (1) is unsafe so as to endanger a person; 1-18 (2) is not equipped in a manner that complies with the 1-19 vehicle equipment standards and requirements established by this 1-20 1-21 chapter; [or] (3)is equipped in a manner prohibited by this 1-22 chapter<u>; or</u> 1-23 (4) transports cargo that is not adequately secured to prevent the cargo from falling from the vehicle. 1-24 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this 1-25 1-26 Act. For the purposes of this section, an offense is committed 1-27 1-28 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense 1-29 occurs before that date. 1-30 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this 1-31 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 1-32

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
