1	AN ACT
2	relating to notice procedures for abatement of certain nuisances.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 683.075, Transportation
5	Code, is amended to read as follows:
6	(a) The procedures for the abatement and removal of a public
7	nuisance under this subchapter must provide not less than 10 days'
8	notice of the nature of the nuisance. The notice must be personally
9	delivered, [er] sent by certified mail with a five-day return
10	requested, or delivered by the United States Postal Service with
11	signature confirmation service to:
12	(1) the last known registered owner of the nuisance;
13	(2) each lienholder of record of the nuisance; and
14	(3) the owner or occupant of:
15	(A) the property on which the nuisance is
16	located; or
17	(B) if the nuisance is located on a public
18	right-of-way, the property adjacent to the right-of-way.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
23	Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
