3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 683.075(a), Transportation Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	(a) The procedures for the abatement and removal of a public
7	nuisance under this subchapter must provide not less than 10 days'
8	notice of the nature of the nuisance. The notice must be personally
9	delivered or sent by the United States Postal Service in a manner
10	that provides for delivery confirmation [certified mail with a
11	five-day return requested] to:
12	(1) the last known registered owner of the nuisance;
13	(2) each lienholder of record of the nuisance; and
14	(3) the owner or occupant of:
15	(A) the property on which the nuisance is
16	located; or
17	(B) if the nuisance is located on a public
18	right-of-way, the property adjacent to the right-of-way.
