8	Sec. 61.9781. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "eligible
9	health professional education program" means:
10	(1) an accredited physician residency training
11	program;
12	(2) an accredited advanced nurse practitioner program
13	leading to registration with the Board of Nurse Examiners as an
14	advanced nurse practitioner;
15	(3) an undergraduate or graduate physician assistant
16	program accredited by the Accreditation Review Commission on
17	Education for the Physician Assistant or its successor; or
18	(4) an accredited undergraduate or graduate allied
19	health program that prepares students to practice as allied health
20	professionals, as defined by 42 U.S.C. Section 295p.
21	Sec. 61.9782. HEALTH PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION GRANTS;
22	PURPOSE. (a) The board may award health professional education
23	grants to eligible health professional education programs at public

or private institutions of higher education in this state to:

Τ	(1) assist the programs in:
2	(A) providing new distance learning or
3	community-based education projects or activities; or
4	(B) expanding or enhancing existing distance

7	(b) The board may not award a grant under this section to

11	subchapter may be used only for a purpose described by Section

13	Sec. 61.9784. ADVISORY COMMITTEE. The board may appoint an
14	advisory committee to advise the board on successful strategies for
15	assisting eligible health professional education programs in
16	providing, expanding, or enhancing distance learning or
17	community-based education projects or activities.
18	Sec. 61.9785. ANNUAL REPORTS. (a) At the end of each
19	academic year for which an eligible health professional education
20	program is awarded a grant under this subchapter and in the form the
21	board requires, the program shall provide to the board a written
22	report regarding the use of the grant.
23	(b) Not later than October 31 of each year, the board shall
24	provide to the governor and the legislature a written report

27	SECTION 2. Beginning with the 2008-2009 academic year, the
