4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 28.010 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 28.010. NOTIFICATION REGARDING COLLEGE CREDIT
8	PROGRAMS. Each school year, a school district shall provide
9	written notification to the parent of each district student
10	enrolled in grade nine or above of the availability of programs in
11	the district under which a student may earn college credit,
12	including advanced placement programs, dual credit programs, joint
13	high school and college credit programs, and international
14	baccalaureate programs.
15	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
16	school year.
17	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
18	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
19	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
20	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
21	Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
