5	SECTION 1. Section 1153.202, Insurance Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to
7	read as follows:
8	(a) Each individual policy or group policy and group
9	certificate <u>must include a written notice stating</u> [ <del>shall provide</del> ]
10	that:
11	(1) if the underlying debt or the insurance terminates
12	before the <u>originally</u> scheduled <u>termination</u> [maturity] date of the
13	insurance [debt], including the termination of a debt by renewing
14	or refinancing the debt, the <u>debtor shall be entitled to a refund of</u>
15	unearned premium; and
16	(2) in the event that the underlying debt or the
17	insurance terminates before the originally scheduled termination
18	date of the insurance, including the termination of a debt by
19	renewing or refinancing the debt, the person who is the holder of
20	the underlying debt instrument on the date the debt terminates
21	shall, no later than 60 days after the termination of the insurance,
22	provide notice to the insurer of the termination of the debt, that
23	includes the name and address of the insured and the payoff date of
24	the underlying debt.

1 <u>(a-1) The</u> refund of any amount <u>of unearned premium</u> paid by 2 or charged to the debtor for insurance shall be paid or credited 3 promptly to the person entitled to the refund <u>no later than 30 days</u> 4 <u>after receipt of the notice required to be sent to the insurer under</u> 5 Subsection (a)(2).

6 <u>(a-2)</u> In any claim or action asserted by an insured against 7 an insurer for failure to refund any unearned premium in accordance 8 with this section, the insurer shall be entitled to indemnity from a 9 holder who failed to provide the notice required under Subsection 10 (a)(2).

SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a credit life or credit 11 accident and health insurance policy evidenced by an individual 12 policy or group certificate of insurance that is delivered, issued 13 for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2008. A policy or 14 15 certificate delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before 16 January 1, 2008, is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in 17 18 effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
