1-8 relating to erecting an off-premise sign adjacent to and visible
1-9 from certain roads.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 391.252, Transportation
1-12 Code, as amended by Chapters 281, 352, 405, 796, 903, 983, 1046, and
1-13 1353, Acts of the 79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005, is
1-14 reenacted and amended to read as follows:

1-15 (a) A person may not erect an off-premise sign that is
1-16 adjacent to and visible from:

1-17 (1) U.S. Highway 290 between the western city limits
1-18 of the city of Austin and the eastern city limits of the city of
1-19 Fredericksburg;

1-20 (2) State Highway 317 between the northern city limits
1-21 of the city of Belton to the southern city limits of the city of
1-22 Valley Mills;

1-23 (3) State Highway 16 between the northern city limits
1-24 of the city of Kerrville and Interstate Highway 20;

1-25 (4) U.S. Highway 77 between State Highway 186 and
1-26 State Highway 44;

1-27 (5) ~~U.S. Highway 281 between State Highway 186 and~~
1-28 ~~Interstate Highway 37, exclusive of the segment of U.S. Highway 281~~
1-29 ~~located in the city limits of Three Rivers;~~

1-30 ~~(5)~~ U.S. Highway 281 between:

1-31 (A) State Highway 186 and Interstate Highway 37;
1-32 and

1-33 (B) the southern boundary line of Comal County
1-34 and State Highway 306;

1-35 (6) State Highway 17 between State Highway 118 and
1-36 U.S. Highway 90;

1-37 (7) State Highway 67 between U.S. Highway 90 and
1-38 Farm-to-Market Road 170;

1-39 (8) Farm-to-Market Road 170 between State Highway 67
1-40 and State Highway 118;

1-41 (9) State Highway 118 between Farm-to-Market Road 170
1-42 and State Highway 17;

1-43 (10) State Highway 105 between the western city limits
1-44 of the city of Sour Lake to the eastern city limits of the city of
1-45 Cleveland;

1-46 (11) State Highway 73 between the eastern city limits
1-47 of the city of Winnie to the western city limits of the city of Port
1-48 Arthur;

1-49 (12) State Highway 21 between the southern city limits
1-50 of the city of College Station and U.S. Highway 290;

1-51 (13) a highway located in:

1-52 (A) the Sabine National Forest;

1-53 (B) the Davy Crockett National Forest; or

1-54 (C) the Sam Houston National Forest; ~~or~~

1-55 (14) Segments 1 through 4 of State Highway 130;

1-56 (15) [(14)] a highway in Bandera County that is part
1-57 of the state highway system;

1-58 (16) [(14)] Farm-to-Market Road 3238 beginning at
1-59 State Highway 71 and any extension of that road through Hays and
1-60 Blanco Counties;

1-61 (17) [(14)] Farm-to-Market Road 2978 between
1-62 Farm-to-Market Road 1488 and the boundary line between Harris and
1-63 Montgomery Counties;

1-64 (18) U.S. [(14) State] Highway 90 between the western

2-2 of the city of Hondo.

2-3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
