## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to loose material transported by vehicle.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 725.001, Transportation Code, is amended
- by amending Subdivision (2) and adding Subdivision (4-a) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (2) "Loose material" means material that can be blown
- 8 or spilled from a vehicle because of movement or exposure to air,
- 9 wind currents, or other weather. The term includes dirt, sand,
- 10 gravel, refuse, and wood chips but excludes an agricultural product
- 11 in its natural state.
- 12 (4-a) "Refuse" means trash, rubbish, garbage, or any
- other discarded material.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 725.002, Transportation Code, is amended
- 15 to read as follows:
- Sec. 725.002. APPLICABILITY. This chapter applies to any
- 17 motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer operated on a public highway
- 18 except[÷
- 19  $\left[\frac{1}{2}\right]$  a vehicle or construction or mining equipment
- 20 that is:
- (1)  $[\frac{A}{A}]$  moving between construction barricades on a
- 22 public works project; or
- 23 (2) [<del>(B)</del>] crossing a public highway[<del>; or</del>
- 24 [(2) a vehicle that is operated at a speed less than 30

- 1 miles per hour].
- 2 SECTION 3. Subsection (a), Section 725.003, Transportation
- 3 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (a) A person or the person's agent or employee may not
- 5 transport loose material[, aggregates, or refuse] in violation of
- 6 this chapter.
- 7 SECTION 4. Subsections (c) and (e), Section 725.021,
- 8 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 9 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (e), the load shall be
- 10 covered and the covering firmly secured at the front and back,
- 11 unless the load:
- 12 (1) is completely enclosed by the load-carrying
- 13 compartment; or
- 14 (2) does not blow from or spill over the top of the
- 15 load-carrying compartment.
- 16 (e) If the vehicle is a commercial motor vehicle
- 17 transporting loose material [aggregates, as defined by Section
- 18 133.003, Natural Resources Code, or refuse], the load shall be
- 19 covered and the covering firmly secured at the front and back or
- 20 shall be completely enclosed by the load-carrying compartment. For
- 21 purposes of this section, "commercial motor vehicle" means a motor
- vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer used primarily in the business of
- 23 transporting property.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
