Section 521.026, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 19 Sec. 521.026. DISMISSAL OF EXPIRED LICENSE CHARGE. (a) A 20 21 judge may dismiss a charge of driving with an expired license if the 22 defendant remedies this defect within 20 [10] working days or 23 before the defendant's first court appearance date, whichever is 24 later.

SECTION 3. Section 548.605(b), Transportation Code, 4 is amended to read as follows: 5 6 (b) The court shall: 7 (1) dismiss a charge of driving with an expired inspection certificate if: 8 (A) the defendant remedies the defect within 20 9 [10] working days or before the defendant's first court appearance 10 11 date, whichever is later; and (B) the inspection certificate has not been 12 expired for more than 60 days; and 13 (2) assess an administrative fee not to exceed \$20 14 15 [\$10] when the charge of driving with an expired inspection certificate has been remedied. 16 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007. 17
