## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to dismissal of the charge in certain motor vehicle
- 3 equipment offenses.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 547.004, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) The court may dismiss a charge of an offense under this
- 8 section involving a vehicle other than a commercial vehicle, as
- 9 defined by Section 548.001, if the defendant presents proof
- 10 satisfactory to the court that the defendant remedied the defect
- 11 within 20 working days after the date of the offense or before the
- 12 defendant's first court appearance date, whichever is later. The
- court may assess an administrative fee not to exceed \$20 when the
- 14 charge is dismissed, or may waive the fee if the waiver is in the
- 15 <u>interest of justice.</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
