5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 31, Parks and Wildlife
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 31.1211 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 31.1211. JURISDICTION OF MUNICIPAL PEACE OFFICERS.
8	(a) Notwithstanding any other law limiting the enforcement
9	jurisdiction of a peace officer, a peace officer of a municipality
10	who is certified as a marine safety enforcement officer under
11	Section 31.121 may enforce the provisions of this chapter within an
12	area of a lake that is outside the enforcement jurisdiction of the
13	<pre>peace officer if:</pre>
14	(1) any portion of the lake is contained in the
15	corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction of the
16	municipality; and
17	(2) the municipality has entered into a memorandum of
18	understanding with the governmental entity having enforcement
19	jurisdiction in that area granting the peace officer enforcement
20	jurisdiction in the area.
21	(b) The memorandum of understanding under Subsection (a)(2)
22	must:
23	(1) designate the jurisdiction that has the authority
24	to conduct any prosecution or ongoing investigation of a violation

resulting from an enforcement action under this section; and
(2) be approved by the Parks and Wildlife Department.
SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
