| 10 | SECTION 2. Section 95.001, Health and Safety Code, is |
| 11 | amended by adding Subdivisions (1-a) and (1-b) and amending |
| 12 | Subdivision (3) to read as follows: |
| 13 | (1-a) "Advisory committee" means the Type 2 Diabetes |
| 14 | <u>Risk Assessment Program Advisory Committee established under</u> |
| 15 | <u>Section 95.006.</u> |
| 16 | (1-b) "Council" means the Texas Diabetes Council. |
| 17 | (3) "Office" means [the Texas-Mexico Border Health |
| 18 | Coordination Office of] The University of Texas-Pan American Border |
| 19 | Health Office. |
| 20 | SECTION 3. Sections 95.002, 95.003, and 95.004, Health and |
| 21 | Safety Code, are amended to read as follows: |
| 22 | Sec. 95.002. <u>TYPE 2 DIABETES</u> [ACANTHOSIS NIGRICANS] |
| 23 | EDUCATION AND <u>RISK ASSESSMENT PROGRAM</u> [SCREENING PROJECT]. |
| 24 | (a) The office shall administer <u>a risk assessment program for Type</u> |
| | |

1 <u>2 diabetes</u> [an acanthosis nigricans screening program] in 2 accordance with this chapter.

3 The office, after reviewing recommendations made by the (b) advisory committee, [executive council] by rule shall coordinate 4 the risk assessment for Type 2 diabetes [screening] of individuals 5 who attend public or private schools located in Texas Education 6 7 Agency Regional Education Service Centers 1, 2, 3, 4, 10, 11, 13, 15, 18, 19, and 20 and, by using existing funding as efficiently as 8 possible or by using other available funding, in additional 9 10 regional education service centers.

11 (c) The rules must include procedures necessary to 12 administer <u>the risk assessment program</u>, including procedures that 13 <u>require each school to record and report risk assessment</u> 14 [<u>screening</u>] activities <u>using:</u>

15 <u>(1) an existing database used to administer and track</u>
16 <u>risk assessment data; or</u>

17 (2) widely accepted surveillance software selected by
 18 the office.

(d) The office shall require <u>a risk assessment for Type 2</u>
 <u>diabetes</u> [acanthosis nigricans screening] to be performed at the
 same time hearing and vision screening is performed under Chapter
 36 or spinal screening is performed under Chapter 37. <u>The risk</u>
 <u>assessment for Type 2 diabetes should:</u>

25 (2) further assess students identified under

27 (A) body mass index; and

| 24 | Sec. 95.003. COMPLIANCE WITH <u>RISK ASSESSMENT</u> [SCREENING] |
| 25 | REQUIREMENTS. (a) Each individual required by rules adopted under |
| 26 | this chapter to be <u>assessed</u> [screened] shall undergo approved <u>risk</u> |
| 27 | assessment [screening] for Type 2 diabetes [acanthosis nigricans]. |

1 The individual shall comply with the requirements as soon as 2 possible after the individual's admission to a school and as 3 required by rule. The individual or, if the individual is a minor, 4 the minor's parent, managing conservator, or guardian may 5 substitute a professional examination for the <u>risk assessment</u> 6 [screening].

7 (b) An individual is exempt from ri<u>sk assessment</u> [screening] if risk assessment [screening] conflicts with the 8 9 tenets and practices of a recognized church or religious 10 denomination of which the individual is an adherent or a member. To qualify for the exemption, the individual or, if the individual is a 11 12 minor, the individual's parent, managing conservator, or guardian must submit to the chief administrator of the school on or before 13 the day of the <u>risk assessment process</u> [screening procedure] an 14 15 affidavit stating the objections to the risk assessment 16 [screening].

17 (c) The chief administrator of each school shall ensure that 18 each individual admitted to the school complies with the <u>risk</u> 19 <u>assessment</u> [screening] requirements set by the <u>office</u> [executive 20 <u>council</u>] or submits an affidavit of exemption.

Sec. 95.004. RECORDS; (a) 21 REPORTS. The chief 22 administrator of each school shall maintain, on a form prescribed by the office, risk assessment [executive council, screening] 23 records for each individual in attendance[$_{ au}$] and enter the risk 24 25 assessment information for each individual on the surveillance software selected by the office. The risk assessment [the] records 26 27 are open for inspection by the office or the local health

1 department.

2 (b) The office may, directly or through local health 3 departments, enter a school and inspect records maintained by the 4 school relating to <u>risk assessment</u> [screening] for <u>Type 2 diabetes</u> 5 [<u>acanthosis nigricans</u>].

6 (c) An individual's <u>risk assessment</u> [screening] records may 7 be transferred among schools without the consent of the individual 8 or, if the individual is a minor, the minor's parent, managing 9 conservator, or guardian.

10 (d) The person performing the <u>risk assessment</u> [screening] 11 shall send a report indicating that an individual may <u>be at risk for</u> 12 <u>developing Type 2 diabetes</u> [have acanthosis nigricans] to the 13 individual or, if the individual is a minor, the minor's parent, 14 managing conservator, or guardian. The report must include:

(1) an explanation of:

16 (A) the process for assessing risk for developing 17 Type 2 diabetes; 18 (B) the reasons the individual was identified in the risk assessment process as being at risk for developing Type 2 19 20 diabetes; (C) the risk factors associated with developing 21 22 Type 2 diabetes; and (D) the individual's body mass index [acanthosis 23 nigricans and related conditions]; 24 25 (2) a statement concerning an individual's or family's

26 need for further evaluation <u>for Type 2 diabetes and related</u> [of] 27 conditions [related to acanthosis nigricans]; [and]

| 2 | receive evaluation by a physician or other health care provider; |

| 4 | (4) information on procedures for applying for the |

| 7 | (e) Each school shall submit to the office an annual report |
| 8 | on the <u>risk assessment</u> [screening] status of the individuals in |
| 9 | attendance during the reporting year and shall include in the |
| 10 | report any other information required by the office. |
| 11 | (f) The report required under Subsection (e) must: |
| 12 | (1) be compiled from the information entered into the |
| 13 | <pre>surveillance software;</pre> |
| 14 | (2) be on a form prescribed by the office; [executive |

| 16 | (3) [must] be submitted according to the <u>timetable</u> |
| 17 | established by the office's [executive council's] rules. |
| 18 | (g) After the end of the reporting period under Subsection |
| 19 | (e), the office shall: |

| 24 | (3) post on an Internet website accessible to each |

| 9 | <u>(i)</u> [(f)] Not later than January 15 of each odd-numbered |
| 10 | year, the office shall submit to the governor and the legislature a |
| 11 | report <u>relating to</u> [concerning] the <u>implementation and</u> |
| 12 | effectiveness of the <u>Type 2 diabetes risk assessment</u> [acanthosis |
| 13 | nigricans screening] program established by this chapter that |
| 14 | includes a detailed description of the expenses related to the |
| 15 | program. |
| 16 | SECTION 4. Chapter 95, Health and Safety Code, is amended by |
| 17 | adding Sections 95.005 and 95.006 to read as follows: |
| 18 | Sec. 95.005. GIFTS AND GRANTS. The office may accept gifts, |
| 19 | grants, and donations to support the Type 2 diabetes risk |
| 20 | assessment program conducted under this chapter. |
| 21 | Sec. 95.006. ADVISORY COMMITTEE. (a) The Type 2 Diabetes |
| 22 | Risk Assessment Program Advisory Committee is established to advise |
| 23 | the office on the Type 2 diabetes risk assessment program conducted |
| 24 | under this chapter. |
| 25 | (b) The advisory committee is composed of: |
| 26 | (1) the following representatives appointed by the |
| 27 | executive director of the office: |

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| 1 | (A) one representative of the office; |
| 2 | (B) one representative of the Texas Education |
| 3 | Agency; |
| 4 | (C) one representative of the Texas Pediatric |
| 5 | <u>Society;</u> |
| 6 | (D) one representative of the American Diabetes |

| 8 | (E) one representative who is a member of the |
| 9 | board of regents of The University of TexasPan American; |
| 10 | (F) one school nurse representative from an urban |

| 15 | (H) one person with knowledge and experience in |
| 16 | health care in school settings; and |

| 4 | (c) A person may not be a member of the advisory committee if |
| 5 | the person is required to register as a lobbyist under Chapter 305, |
| 6 | Government Code, because of the person's activities for |
| 7 | compensation on behalf of a health care profession or related |
| 8 | business or another profession related to the operation of the |
| 9 | council. |
| 10 | (d) The representative of the office appointed under |
| 11 | Subsection (b)(1)(A) shall serve as the presiding officer of the |
| 12 | advisory committee. |
| 13 | (e) The advisory committee shall meet at least twice a year |
| 14 | and at other times at the call of the presiding officer. The |
| 15 | advisory committee may meet by teleconference if an in-person |
| 16 | meeting of all the members is not practicable. |
| 17 | (f) Members of the advisory committee may not receive |
| 18 | compensation for service on the committee. An advisory committee |
| 19 | member is entitled to reimbursement of travel expenses incurred by |
| 20 | the member while conducting the business of the advisory committee |
| 21 | to the extent that funds are available to the office for that |
| 22 | purpose. |
| 23 | (g) Chapter 2110, Government Code, does not apply to the |
| 24 | size, composition, or duration of the advisory committee. |

schools that do not employ a school nurse; 1 2 (2) advise the office on the age groups that would 3 benefit most from the risk assessment activities under this 4 chapter; 5 (3) recommend a method to record and report the number 6 of children who are identified in the risk assessment process as 7 being at risk for having or developing Type 2 diabetes and who qualify for the national free or reduced-price lunch program 8 9 established under 42 U.S.C. Section 1751 et seq.; 10 (4) recommend a deadline, which may not be later than the first anniversary of the date the advisory committee submits a 11 recommendation to the office under this section, by which the 12 13 office shall implement the advisory committee's recommended risk assessment activities, surveillance methods, reports, and quality 14 15 improvements; 16 (5) contribute to the state plan for diabetes 17 treatment developed by the council under Section 103.013 by 18 providing statistics and information on the risk assessment activities conducted under this chapter and recommendations for 19 20 assisting children in this state at risk for developing Type 2 diabetes; and 21 22 (6) recommend any additional information to be included in the report required by Section 95.004. 23 (i) The advisory committee shall submit to the office a 24 25 report of the recommendations developed under Subsection (h) not later than September 1 of each even-numbered year. The office, 26 27 subject to the availability of funds, shall implement each advisory

this Act.
