1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the operation of hybrid motor vehicles.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 224.153, Transportation Code, is amended  
1-13 by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

1-14 (e) A motor vehicle displaying the "hybrid vehicle"  
1-15 insignia authorized by Section 502.1861 in an easily readable  
1-16 location on the back of the vehicle may use a high occupancy vehicle  
1-17 lane regardless of the number of occupants in the vehicle unless:

1-18 (1) the use would impair the receipt of federal funds;

1-19 or

1-20 (2) the department determines that the high occupancy  
1-21 vehicle lane has reached 80 percent of its vehicle capacity.

1-22 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,  
1-23 is amended by adding Section 502.1861 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 502.1861. "HYBRID VEHICLE" INSIGNIA FOR CERTAIN MOTOR  
1-25 VEHICLES. (a) At the time of registration or reregistration of  
1-26 the motor vehicle, the department shall issue a specially designed  
1-27 "hybrid vehicle" insignia for a motor vehicle that draws propulsion  
1-28 energy from both gasoline or conventional diesel fuel and from a  
1-29 rechargeable energy storage system.

1-30 (b) The department shall issue a "hybrid vehicle" insignia  
1-31 under this section without the payment of any additional fee to a  
1-32 person who:

1-33 (1) applies to the department on a form provided by the  
1-34 department; and

1-35 (2) submits proof that the motor vehicle being  
1-36 registered is a vehicle described by Subsection (a).

1-37 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
