11	(2) a surviving <u>minor</u> child <u>as defined by Section</u>
12	615.001[, if the child was claimed as a dependent on the income tax
13	return filed with the Internal Revenue Service by the listed
14	individual in the year preceding the year in which the listed
15	individual died].
16	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Subsection
17	(a), Section 615.0225, Government Code, regarding the eligibility
18	of a surviving child for educational benefits applies in relation
19	to a death that occurs on or after September 1, 2001. However, that
20	change applies only with respect to education benefits awarded by
21	an institution of higher education beginning with the 2007 fall
22	semester.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
