S.B. No. 458

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to workers' compensation medical benefits for certain
3 prosthetic or orthotic devices.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 401.011, Labor Code, is amended by
6 amending Subdivision (19) and adding Subdivisions (34-a) and (35-a)
7 to read as follows:

8 (19) "Health care" includes all reasonable and
9 necessary medical aid, medical examinations, medical treatments,
10 medical diagnoses, medical evaluations, and medical services. The
11 term does not include vocational rehabilitation. The term
12 includes:

13 (A) medical, surgical, chiropractic, podiatric,
14 optometric, dental, nursing, and physical therapy services
15 provided by or at the direction of a doctor;

16 (B) physical rehabilitation services performed
17 by a licensed occupational therapist provided by or at the
18 direction of a doctor;

19 (C) psychological services prescribed by a
20 doctor;

21 (D) the services of a hospital or other health
22 care facility;

23 (E) a prescription drug, medicine, or other
24 remedy; and

1 (F) a medical or surgical supply, appliance,
2 brace, artificial member, or prosthetic or orthotic device
3 [~~prosthesis~~], including the fitting of, change or repair to, or
4 training in the use of the appliance, brace, member, or device
5 [~~prosthesis~~].

6 (34-a) "Orthotic device" means a custom-fitted or
7 custom-fabricated medical device that is applied to a part of the
8 human body to correct a deformity, improve function, or relieve
9 symptoms related to a compensable injury or occupational disease.

10 (35-a) "Prosthetic device" means an artificial device
11 designed to replace, wholly or partly, an arm or leg.

12 SECTION 2. Section 1305.004(b), Insurance Code, is amended
13 to read as follows:

14 (b) In this chapter, the following terms have the meanings
15 assigned by Section 401.011, Labor Code:

- 16 (1) "compensable injury";
17 (2) "doctor";
18 (3) "employer";
19 (4) "health care";
20 (5) "health care facility";
21 (6) "health care practitioner";
22 (7) "health care provider";
23 (8) "injury";
24 (9) "insurance carrier"; [~~and~~]
25 (10) "orthotic device";
26 (11) "prosthetic device"; and
27 (12) "treating doctor."

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
