- 2 relating to the dismissal of a charge for failure to timely update
- 3 certain information on a driver's license or personal
- 4 identification certificate.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 521.054, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 8 (d) A court may dismiss a charge for a violation of this
- 9 section if the defendant remedies the defect not later than the 20th
- 10 working day after the date of the offense and pays an administrative
- 11 fee not to exceed \$20. The court may waive the administrative fee if
- 12 the waiver is in the interest of justice.
- SECTION 2. (a) The changes in law made by this Act apply
- only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 15 Act. For the purposes of this section, an offense is committed
- 16 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense
- 17 occurs before that date.
- 18 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 19 Act is governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
