A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the funding and promotion of the Save Texas History and 3 Adopt-A-Beach programs of the General Land Office. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 31.0655, Natural Resources Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 FUNDING AND PROMOTION OF 7 Sec. 31.0655. [STATE EMPLOYEE 8 CONTRIBUTIONS TO] SAVE TEXAS HISTORY AND ADOPT-A-BEACH PROGRAMS. (a) For purposes of Subchapter I, Chapter 659, Government Code: 9 the land office, for the sole purpose of managing 10 (1)11 the Save Texas History and Adopt-A-Beach programs, is considered an 12 eligible charitable organization entitled to participate in the state employee charitable campaign; and 13 14 (2) a state employee is entitled to authorize а 15 deduction for contributions to the land office for the purposes of managing the Save Texas History and Adopt-A-Beach programs as a 16 charitable contribution under Section 659.132, Government Code, 17 and the land office may use the contributions for the purpose of: 18 preserving historic maps and documents under 19 (A) the Save Texas History program; or 20 21 (B) administering the Adopt-A-Beach program. 22 (b) The land office may promote and advertise the Save Texas 23 History and Adopt-A-Beach programs by: 24 (1) using current market research to develop a

2	(2) providing information, education, and training to
3	promote the benefits of the programs; and
4	(3) using other methods the land office considers
5	appropriate.
6	(c) The land office may use for administrative purposes
7	related to the Save Texas History and Adopt-A-Beach programs money
8	appropriated for those programs, state employee charitable
9	campaign contributions received for those programs, or other
10	donations received that are available for those purposes.
11	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
