- 7 (a) The comptroller shall prescribe uniform accounting and
- 8 financial reporting procedures that each state agency shall use in
- 9 the preparation of the information requested under Section
- 10 2101.011. The procedures may include procedures that prescribe a
- 11 uniform format for and a uniform method of reporting the financial
- 12 information included in the annual financial report.
- 13 <u>(d) The comptroller may adopt rules to implement this</u>
- 14 section.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 2101.035, Government Code, is amended by
- 16 adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 17 (h) State agencies shall report expenditures in the uniform
- 18 manner required by the comptroller.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
