4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subsections (a), (b), and (c), Section 2053.151,
6	Insurance Code, are amended to read as follows:

3	[(5) the amount paid in periodic payments;

8	[(C) supplemental income benefits; and
9	[ <del>(D) death and burial benefits;</del>
10	[ <del>(8) the total amount paid for:</del>

- 3 (c) The commissioner <u>by rule shall establish reporting</u>
- 4 requirements for insurance companies regarding workers'
- 5 compensation claims [may allow the information required by
- 6 Subsection (a) to be reported in the aggregate for each risk for
- 7 claims in which benefit payments are less than \$5,000]. The
- 8 commissioner may reduce or eliminate reporting requirements for
- 9 <u>insurance companies whose workers' compensation insurance business</u>
- 10 falls below a specific minimum premium volume established by the
- 11 <u>commissioner by rule</u> [adjust the \$5,000 threshold for aggregate
- 12 reporting to account for inflationary changes].
- 13 SECTION 2. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 14 over another Act of the 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007,
- 15 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 16 codes.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
