- 9 423rd Judicial District is composed of Bastrop County.
- SECTION 2. Section 44.111(a), Government Code, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 (a) The criminal district attorney of Bastrop County shall
- 13 attend each term and session of the district <u>courts</u> [court] in
- 14 Bastrop County and each term and session of the inferior courts of
- the county held for the transaction of criminal business. He shall
- 16 exclusively represent the state in all criminal matters before
- 17 those courts and any other court in which Bastrop County has pending
- 18 business.
- 19 SECTION 3. (a) For purposes of Section 201.027, Election
- 20 Code, the effective date of this Act is January 1, 2009.
- 21 (b) Notwithstanding Section 24.311, Government Code, the
- 22 initial vacancy in the office of judge of the 423rd Judicial
- 23 District shall be filled by election. The office exists for
- 24 purposes of the primary and general election in 2008. A vacancy

- 1 after the initial vacancy is filled as provided by Section 28,
- 2 Article V, Texas Constitution.
- 3 SECTION 4. The 423rd Judicial District is created January
- 4 1, 2009.
- 5 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
